

Call for Additional Working Group Co-Leaders

***CliMent* COST action**

We are pleased to announce the opening of applications for additional **co-leadership positions** within **three Working Groups** of the *CliMent* COST Action (**Working Groups 1, 2 [two positions] and 3**), which began on 29/10/2024 and will end on 28/10/2028.

1. Objective

Co-leaders will be responsible for:

- Supporting the coordination and management of activities and tasks aligned with the scientific and networking objectives of the COST Action, specifically within their assigned Working Group.
- Ensuring compliance with COST Principles and Rules, as well as the Memorandum of Understanding ([MoU](#)) objectives.
- Contributing to the preparation of progress reports and the dissemination of results and outputs generated by the Working Group to maximize the impact of the COST Action.

2. Eligibility Criteria and Selection Process

Applicants will be evaluated based on the following criteria:

- Their active membership in an existing working group (self-assessment encouraged).
- Their demonstrated availability, motivation to engage in the tasks outlined above and dedication to complete the working group deliverables in a timely manner.
- Their prior strong engagement and demonstrated commitment to working group's objectives.
- Their background and experience related to the working group they apply for and its corresponding deliverables.
- COST action commitment to balanced representation, including considerations of gender, country diversity, and participation from Inclusiveness Target Countries (ITCs).

The applications will be assessed and elected directly by the Management Committee, either by e-vote if it is just one candidate or by MC meeting if several candidates.

3. Application Process

- A curriculum vitae (CV).
- A motivation letter detailing
 - To which Working group co-leadership they wish to apply,
 - Their current implication in Climent COST action,
 - Specific tasks or expertise within the Working Group they wish to contribute to,
 - Any additional proposals or ideas for the Working Group and or the COST action.
