

## **Communication Activity**

This Virtual Mobility (VM) primarily focused on coordinating the data extraction phase of a forthcoming scoping review. The VM successfully brought together 55 researchers from 24 countries to establish a harmonized framework for data extraction.

To communicate the outcomes and relevance of this work to a broader audience, I plan to prepare a short post summarizing the goals and collaborative achievements of this VM on professional social media platforms such as LinkedIn and Twitter (X). The post will highlight how international coordination among researchers contributes to building standardized and transparent research practices. If possible, this information will also be shared through the COST Action's official communication channels or institutional webpages. In addition, the scoping review protocol will be made publicly available on the Open Science Framework (OSF) to promote transparency and accessibility of the research process.

In the longer term, once the scoping review is completed and published, its results will also be disseminated through open-access publication and simplified summaries accessible to non-specialist audiences. This will help raise awareness among laypeople about how international research collaboration strengthens scientific quality and promotes openness in mental health research.
